Statistical Analysis of Self Help Groups in Karnataka State with Special Reference to Haveri District

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Abstract: Self-help groups are voluntarily formed group consist of 10-20 people with the combination of men and women for economically homogeneous classes, who come together for addressing their common problems and issues. These kinds of groups can be seen in rural and semi urban places more. There are generally formed with mutual agreement to make regular savings and contribute the same for common fund to facilitate the lending of small interest bearing loans to their group members. This makes group members to avoid high rate of interest lenders in their locality and easy access for loan and all. When they have their own group, as and when monetary and non-monetary assistance required for their problems, they can find solution them self without depending upon others. So it makes them easy to access fund and easy to repay with minute rate of interest. This is the main advantage for the group members.

If Self Help Groups maintain good financial track record they can get credit assistance from government and non-government bodies. That credit facility can be used not only for their personal but also for their economic development individually or in a group. It can become their source of income and it may change their style of living by improving their standard of life it will help to improvement in economic development of the country also. This article endeavor to throw light upon self-help groups operations and their status in Haveri district of Karnataka State.

I. INTRODUCTION

Self Help Group (SHG), came in to existence almost two decades ago which is now a well-known concept. This is a village- based financial intermediary committee usually composed of 10-20 local women or men. A Mixed group is generally not preferred. Self-help group members make small regular savings contributions over a few months until there is enough capital in the group to begin lending. Funds may then be lent back to the members or to others in the village for any purpose. In India, many SHG's are 'linked' to banks for the delivery of micro credit. Self Help Groups are seen as instrument for a variety of goals including empowering women, developing leadership abilities among poor people, increasing school enrollments, and improving nutrition and the use of birth control. Self Help Groups are considered as agents of socio-economic transformation in rural areas. The present study is an attempt to analysis the growth trend of SHG's, increasing trend of number of members in SHG's, loan received from the banks and savings of SHG's in Haveri district.

II. STUDY AREA

Haveri District was fromed on 24th August 1997 by dividing the earlier Dharwad District into Dharwad, Haveri and Gadag districts. The district comprising seven taluks viz Bydagi, Hangal, Haveri, Hirekerur,

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Ranebennur, Savanur and Shiggaon and two revenue divisions, i.e. Haveri and Savanur. The total geographical area of the district is 4851 sq.kms. It shares to the total geographical area of the Karnataka State is hardly 2.52 percent.

Haveri district is located exactly in the center of Karnataka State with equal distance from Bidar in the north to Kollegal in the south. It is also known as the gateway district of the northern districts of Karnataka State. It extends between north latitudes 14⁰ 17'20" to 15⁰ 5' 55' and east longitudes 75⁰ 0' 35" to 75⁰ 49' 23". The length of the district from north to south is 82 kms and width from east to west is 72 kms. See Map No - 01

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS OF HAVERI DISTRICT



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III. OBJECTIVES

The paper is deals with the following objectives:

- > To find out the growth trend of SHG's in Haveri district
- > To analyse the total number of members in SHG's of Study area
- To analyse the category wise members of SHG's
- To access the taluk wise accumulated saving amount in the banks by SHG's
- To examine the taluk wise loan received from the banks by SHG's of Study area.

IV. DATA BASE AND METHODOLOGY

The data which is being utilized throughout the work of this paper is mainly based on secondary data collected from district census hand books and the data has been analysed with the help of statistical diagrams.

V. SELF HELP IN KARNATAKA

Karnataka is in third place in formation of more number of SHG's in India. In Karnataka SHG's are called as Stri Shakti Sangh or Swashakti Sangha. The main motto of formation of SHG's is Empowering Women who are economically and socially backward. First loan in Karnataka for SHSG's was given to an SHG called Venkateshwara Mahila Sangha of Mudugali of Kolar district by the Vysya Bank, Bangarpet branch on December 9th 1991 and to an SHG called Sarswathi Mahila Sangha in Boduguriki on January 30th 1992 by the Corporation Bank,Andersonpet Branch¹. As on 29th December 2014 there are 271331Self Help Groups in Karnataka State. Out of which 45063(16.6%) are belongs to SC, 19256(7%) are belongs to ST, 53461(19.7%) are belongs to OBC and 144857(53.3%) are belongs to other categories see table no – 01 and graph no - 2. As per the same records 93.4 percent members are belongs to Hindu, 5.4 percent members are belongs to Muslims religion and remaining 1.2 percent members are belongs to Sikh,Jain,Christain,Buddhist and Parsis religions. 

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
Religion Wise Number of Members in Self Help Groups of Karnataka State (As on 29th December 2014)


(A) GROWTH TREND OF SHG's IN HAVERI DISTRICT: - In Haveri district there is a gradual increase of of SHG's from 2007 to 2011 and from 2011 to 2014. Among all the seven taluks of the district the highest percentage i.e, 7 percent is increased in Bydagi and Hirekerur Taluks(2007-2011). In between 2011 and 2014 the number of SHG's has increased by 13 percent and 12 percent in Ranebenur and Hirekerur taluks. The least percent i.e., 01 percent of SHG numbers has increased in Ranebennur taluk between 2007 – 2011, and in between 2011 – 2014 only 6 percent has increased in Shiggaon taluk. Over all during the period of 2011 – 2014 the number of SHG's has increased by 4 percent to 9 percent in the study area. It can be seen in table no: - 03 and graph no: - 03.


Number of Self Help Groups (Sthree Shakti Sangha) in Haveri District (2007-2014)

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(B) TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS IN SHG's:- More number of SHG's is the strength of the group. Potentiality of the group is based on total number of members, because more number of members will do more savings, it helps to rotate the money within the members for loan purposes, and even it will help in taking loan in banks also.

Table no -04 and graph no-04 shows the numbers of participation in SHG's in Haveri district. In 2007-2011 the highest percentage of members' participation in SHG's of is found in Savanur and in Byadagi taluks, 68 percent and 6.6 percent respectively. In between 2011 - 14 the trend has shifted to Hirekerur and in Ranebennur taluks, in this period it was registered by 15 percent and with 9 percent.


The minimum number of SHG's members should be 10 and maximum number should be 20. It should be 10 - 20 to create homogenous, of SHG's. In the district Five taluks like Byadagi, Hangal, Haveri, Hirekerur and Ranebennur (71%) are having 16 members average in their groups and remaining Two taluks i.,e. Savanur and Shiggaon (29%) SHG's are having 14 members average in their groups. It is better to have 20 members to make all activities stronger.



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(C) SHG's AND SC MEMBERS: - In the study area the number of SC members of SHG's has increased by 2.1 percent i., e, from 13.4 percent to 15.5 percent during the period of 2007 and 2011, but in between 2011- 14 it is just increased by 0.1 percent only, i., e, from 15.5 percent to 15.6 percent. During the period of 2007-11 except Savanur taluk the number of SC members in SHG's has slightly increased by 0.1 percent only but in Savanur taluk the number of SC members in SHG's has increased by 7.9 percent. It can be seen in the table no -05 and graph no -05.

(D) SHG's AND ST MEMBERS: - During the period of 2007-11 and 2011 -14 the ST members of SHG's in Haveri district has gradually decreased from 16.3 percent to 13.1 percent and from 13.1 percent to 11.6 percent. The same think is reflects in all the seven taluks of the study area but the drastic decrease has record in Savanur taluk only. In Savanur taluk percentage of ST members has decreased from 35.3 percent to 12.5 percent in between 2007-2011. See table no - 06 and graph no – 06.



Category wise Members in Self Help Groups(Sthree Shakti Sangha) In Haveri District (2007-2014)



Among all the seven taluks Byadagi taluk has highest (82%) percent of the other category members in 2014 and least percentage (65%) other category members are found in Savanur taluk. 

(F) SHG's AND SAVINGS: - Savings is thrift is a human habit, and it is the main objective of every SHG's also. Savings made by the SHG's in the banks or Co-operative society's can be use full to get loans from the banks or Co-operative society's also. In the study area the accumulated saving amount has increased from 1490 laksh to 3017 lakhs during the period of 2007 and 2011 and to 4552 lakhs during the period of 2011 - 2014. The savings made by the SHG's is an indicator of the strength of the SHG's. Among all the seven taluks in the district, the SHG's of Hirekerur taluks has the highest (987.1 lakhs) amount of savings in the banks / Co-operative societies (2014). 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

(G) SHG's AND LOAN AMOUNT RECEIVED FROM THE BANKS: - SHG's members are eligible to avail the loan from banks this loan amount can be used for various purpose. In 2014 the SHG's of the study area have received 3070 lakhs rupees of loan from different banks. It is lesser than the savings made by the SHG's of the study area. In this year the SHG's of the study area have saved 4552.5 lakh rupees. The loan amount received by the banks has decreased by 3358 lakhs (2011) to 3070 lakhs (2014) it shows the awareness about savings among the members of SHG's in the study area. In 2014 among the saven taluks the SHG's of Renebennur taluk have received the highest (915.70 lakhs) amount of loan from the banks, and the SHG's of Savanur taluk have received least (209.50 lakhs) amount of loan from the banks. 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VI. CONCLUSION

With the statistical analysis of SHG's of Haveri district it can be concluded that the number of SHG's is gradually increased and number of SHG's members are also gradually increasing from 2007 – 2011 and 2011 – 2014. The accumulated saving amount has also increased by 102 percent in 2011 and 50.8 percent in 2014. It depicts the awareness about the savings among the SHG's members.

According to 2011 data the women population of Bydagi taluk (68931) is lesser than the Savanur (78192) taluk, but the number of SHG's and number of members in SHG's is more in Bydagi taluk when compare to Savanur taluk. So it is necessary to creating awareness about the importance of SHG in Savanur taluk women and helps the women to be economically sound and independent. It will also help them to realize their dreams easily.

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
